

# Supplies for Art Journaling ... Leslie Wood

## Basic supplies for students to bring:

- Scissors
- Pencil
- Charcoal Pencil
- Paint: bring your favorite colors (bring at least two shades of same color (I use cheap Anita brand Craft paints))
- Journal (recycle old desk calendar, or buy a new journal or spiral drawing book (5 ½ x 8 ½ inches is good size, but you can work larger if desired)
- Couple of sheets of patterned scrapbooking paper (or small pad of scrapbook decorative papers)
- Matt Gel Medium or matt Modge Podge
- Old magazine
- Texture stamps (if you have some)
- Letter stamps (if you have some)
- 'StazOn' ink (I like black but color is optional)
- 3-4 paint brushes (size 8 or 10 flats are good, but bring variety)
- Favorite pens (I like Staples Sonix gel black pens also like Soufflé and Glacee pens (found at Hobby Lobby) and Sharpie Poster Paints (Fine point); Sharpie bright colors only available online at somewhere like Dick Blick)

## Optional supplies (instructor will bring extra)

Favorite quotes

Color or black and white photograph (size it to fit inside your journal (ink jet printed onto transparency))

Collage papers such as old papers, old stamps, old labels, old letters, can be anything

White Gesso

Heat gun
